In our state where 40% of the population belongs to children, the issue of children in the under-age group is very complicated. Where Child labour is an offense under the Child Labour Act, many children are being used for this crime. There is a child protection system in the state, but the Juvenile Justice System is expected to be in all the systems and processes of the service providers. On one hand where the need for care and protection of children is increasing significantly, on the other hand the number of children affected by legal conflicts is increasing at a large rate.
